Patrick O'Keeffe Testival Young Musician Winners

The Patrick O'Keeffe Traditional Music Festival is delighted to announce the winners of this year's Young Musician Award. In 2024, the festival honors two exceptional young talents: Michael Healy (accordion) from Kilcummin, Co. Kerry, and Áine Teape (flute and uilleann pipes) from Ballinspittle, Co. Cork. Both musicians will perform at the highly anticipated Sliabh Luachra Concert on Saturday, October 26th as part of the festival.

The Young Musician Award, introduced in 2021, aims to inspire young musicians to immerse themselves in the rich musical traditions of Sliabh Luachra, promoting and preserving the unique style of music synonymous with the region.

Michael Healy – Accordion

Michael Healy, from Kilcummin, is the current All-Ireland Fleadh Cheoil 15–18 Button Accordion Champion. Michael began his musical journey at the age of six, inspired by legendary accordion players such as Jimmy Doyle and other Sliabh Luachra icons like Paudie O'Connor, Bryan O'Leary, and Jackie Daly. He has been a regular participant and winner in All-Ireland Fleadh Cheoil competitions, excelling in both button accordion and melodeon.



Michael has also had the privilege of playing alongside greats like Jimmy Doyle and Joe O'Sullivan at the Arbutus in Killarney, this greatly influenced his playing. A regular participant in traditional music sessions in Browne's Bar Castleisland alongside his brother Kirill, Michael is well known to the traditional music community in Sliabh Luachra. His mentors include Conor Morarty, Mike Brosnan, and Padraig Buckley. Paudie O'Connor, will tutor him in preparation for his performance at the festival.

Áine Teape – Flute and Uilleann Pipes

Áine Teape hails from Ballinspittle, Co. Cork, and is an accomplished musician on both the flute and uilleann pipes. She began learning the flute at age eight, under the tutelage of renowned teachers like Rosaire Cagney, Conal O'Grada, and Joanne Quirke. Her passion for the haunting sound of the uilleann pipes led her to study with John Mitchell.

In 2024, Áine won the Senior Flute Slow Airs competition at the All-Ireland Fleadh in

Wexford, and she continues to draw inspiration from the rich musical tradition of Sliabh Luachra, particularly from the works of Maurice O'Keeffe and Dan Herlihy.

Both Michael and Áine have chosen remarkable mentors for their upcoming performances at the Sliabh Luachra Concert. Michael has selected Paudie O'Connor, one of his early influences and a leading figure in Sliabh Luachra music, while Áine has chosen to work with Eibhlin de Paor a master of the concert flute.




Dedication to the Music of Sliabh Luachra Award

The festival is delighted to announce John Walsh as the chosen recipient of this years "Dedication to the Music of Sliabh Luachra Award.

John Walsh is a fiddle player and composer from Derrygallon, near Kanturk. John has composed countless tunes which today would be considered staples of any Sliabh Luachra session. His tunes are played around the world and many a times he's been confronted with people playing his tunes in sessions without anyone realising the composer is alive and kicking, and standing right beside them!

John received a handful of lessons from Dan Roger

O'Sullivan but was largely self-taught. A nephew of Sonny O'Riordan, who would have been a big influence on him in later years. He has an in depth knowledge and understanding of the notation methods of Patrick O'Keeffe and Tom Billy Murphy. Jackie Daly, is one of many leading musicians who has played John's compositions all of the world.

John Walsh is also one of the key players that contributed to the founding of the Patrick O'Keeffe Traditional Music Festival. It was John's persistent letter writing to RTE which eventually prompted Peter Browne to produce the seminal 4 part RTE Radio 1 documentary on Patrick O'Keeffe in early 1993. Titled "The Last of the Great Fiddle Masters" it focused on the life and times of Patrick O'Keeffe. The documentary coincided with the 30th anniversary of his death. The documentary provided the impetus and inspiration for the festival, which was held for the first time in 1993.

In Peter's words "In late 1992 when John Walsh, an RTÉ worker in the southern area and a fine fiddle-player and composer of tunes, suggested to me that a programme be done on Pádraig's life and times, the reason being that a good number of his pupils were now themselves in the autumn of their lives and the memories of Pádraig should be saved. I can say for John that he persisted until a visit was made and I spoke to four of Pádraig's pupils for about half an hour each one night in Tom Fleming's pub in Scartaglen. These men, Sonny Riordan, Mickey Duggan, Paddy O'Connell and Páidi Gleeson spoke lovingly and warmly of their fiddle teacher and it now seemed that the complete story should be looked at - no-one could leave it at that."

John has attended most if not all of the iterations of the festival. While usually preferring to exist in the background and behind the scenes the festival committee believe it is well time to honour the immense contribution this man has made to the music of Sliabh Luachra. The award will be presented on Saturday the 26th of October at 8pm in The River Island Hotel.






