

Patrick O'Keeffe Festival Young Musician Winners

The Patrick O'Keeffe Traditional Music Festival proudly announces the winners of the 2025 Young Musician Award. This year, the prize recognizes two outstanding young performers: *Eoin Foley* (button accordion) from Kilcummin, Co. Kerry, and *Emma Kelly* (fiddle and flute) from Newmarket, Co. Cork. Both musicians will perform at the highly anticipated Sliabh Luachra Concert on Saturday, October 25th as part of the festival.

The Young Musician Award, introduced in 2021, supports emerging musicians to immerse themselves in the rich musical traditions of Sliabh Luachra, preserving and promoting the region's unique style.

Eoin Foley - Button Accordion

Eoin Foley, Kilcummin, is the current All-Ireland Fleadh Cheoil 12–15 Button Accordion Champion, claiming the title for the second time. He reached the final of the prestigious Siansa Gael Linn competition in Dublin with the group "Teoireann." Eoin began playing at age 7 and has learned with tutors including Bryan O'Leary, Conor Moriarty, and Mike Brosnan.



His musical style is shaped by local Sliabh

Luachra legends like Bryan O'Leary, John Brosnan, and the late Jimmy Doyle. Eoin had the honor of playing alongside the late Seamus Begley in Nelligans Bar, Dingle, and is a regular performer at Handed Down in Scartaglen and Brownes Bar in Castleisland.

For his festival performance, Eoin has chosen Paudie O'Connor as his tutor.

Emma Kelly – Fiddle and Flute

Emma Kelly is a 19-year-old fiddle and flute player from Newmarket, Co. Cork, currently studying Science Education at UCC. She started fiddle at age 6 and flute at 11, taking inspiration from teachers such as Alan Finn, John McNulty, Noreen O'Connor, Damhnait Sweeney, Aideen Quinlan, and Emma Moynihan. Growing up in a family that cherished Sliabh Luachra music, Emma's musical development was constantly encouraged.



Emma has a string of competition successes, including county and Munster Fleadh medals, the Cork ETB School of Music Senior Student of the Year (2022), Larry Reynolds u18 All Ireland Fiddle (2022), Maurice O'Keeffe Overall Musician (2023), finalist in the Fiddler of London (2024), and a member of the All-Ireland winning u18 Crossfields Ceili Band (2024). She currently teaches music for Freemount Comhaltas and enjoys playing with her sisters Sarah and Rachel, notably in 'Dan Shine and friends' sessions.

Emma has chosen Emma O'Leary as her tutor for the Sliabh Luachra Concert.

Both Eoin and Emma are shining examples of the next generation of Sliabh Luachra musicians, dedicated to tradition, excellence, and community spirit. Their performances will be central highlights of this year's festival.

Dedication to the Music of Sliabh Luachra Award

Billy Clifford is a renowned Sliabh Luachra flute player, born in London in 1943 to the celebrated musicians John and Julia Clifford. Deeply influenced by the musical traditions of his ancestral home in Lisheen, County Kerry, Billy learned his first tunes from family and local masters such as Art O'Keeffe and his uncle Denis Murphy. His early career saw him play alongside his parents in the Star of Munster Ceili Band, with their music gaining recognition across Ireland and London.



Billy further developed his style in London, absorbing influences from exceptional musicians like Johnny Gorman, Bobby Casey, Kevin Burke, and Roger Sherlock. Returning to Ireland, Billy settled in Tipperary, dedicating decades to performing, recording, and teaching the intricate Sliabh Luachra style—particularly rich in polkas and slides, a rarity for flute players. His album "Echoes of Sliabh Luachra" is widely regarded as a masterful representation of the region's music.

Billy has a very strong and enduring connection with the Patrick O'Keeffe Traditional Music Festival, where he has regularly performed in concert and taught workshops, inspiring countless young musicians. His dedication and influence were recently acknowledged with the "Dedication to the Music of Sliabh Luachra Award". Among his many students, Simon Crehan won the inaugural Patrick O'Keeffe Festival Young Musician Award, highlighting Billy's significant legacy as both a performer and mentor. His contributions continue to link generations and sustain the living tradition of Sliabh Luachra music within the vibrant festival and beyond.








